Dear X,

I have enclosed a brief synopsis of Richard Kalinoski's newest play *Front Room*, which has been developed with the help of two directors—Mark Hallen at Eastern University and Mark Ulrich, director and actor from Chicago. Readings/workshops were conducted at Eastern University in 2011 near Philadelphia, and at professional theaters in Milwaukee – 2012 and 2013. Front Room can be produced using four actors (one male, three female).

The play examines an unusual attraction between an accomplished University Theater director and her ambitious, somewhat older acting student. When a bond of friendship and romance develops, the esteemed theater professor's intriguing liaison with a veteran of the Iraq war (the acting student) is seriously threatened by the professor's overweening mother – a desperate **hoarder**.

The play explores the moral quandary stemming from an implicit obligation to care for an aging, irascible parent, in the midst of anxious yearning for a richer personal life. *Front Room* uses thematic references to the *Glass Menagerie* by Tennessee Williams and *Jane Eyre* by Charlotte Bronté.
